1. In the present writ petition, the petitioner is praying for issuance of a direction to the respondents to step up the pay of the petitioner at par with junior/respondent No.4, by removing the pay anomaly.
2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner relies on the notification dated 22.08.2019 (Annexure P-1).
3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner, on instructions from the petitioner, submits that at this stage, petitioner will be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.2/Competent Authority to decide the legal notice dated 22.05.2024 (Annexure P-2) served by the petitioner, in a time bound manner.



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4. Learned State counsel does not object to the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2/Competent Authority to consider and decide the legal notice dated 22.05.2024 (Annexure P-2), served by the petitioner within a period of 03 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order in accordance with law.

6. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand(s) disposed of accordingly.
