1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner for directions to the respondents No.1 & 2 to consider the case of petitioner for premature release sympathetically and also in view of the fact that the petitioner is 70% disabled person, as per Haryana Prison Rules, 2022.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Since advance notice has already been served upon the State, Mr. Ramender Singh Chauhan, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents-State. Hence, the service of notice upon the State is hereby dispensed with.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that although the representation has not been filed before any authority, yet, the petitioner would be satisfied if the present petition is treated as representation of the

petitioner and a direction for disposal of the same is given to the respondent No.1.

5. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts and circumstances, in the interest of justice, the present petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.1 to treat the copy of present petition as a representation of the petitioner, and decide the same by passing a speaking order within a period of one month from the date of receipt of copy of instant order. It is however clarified that no finding is being returned, by this Court, with regard to merits of the contents of the petition/representation. The respondent No.1 shall be at liberty to make an independent assessment with regard to contents of the representation, and take an independent decision at his own level.

6. The registry is directed to send the copy of this order, alongwith the copy of present petition, to the respondent No.1.
