This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to reinstate/restore payment of pensionary benefits to the petitioner till such time OA (Appeal) No. 1114 of 2020 remains sub judice and is presently pending before the Armed Forces Tribunal, Regional Bench, Chandigarh.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition, with liberty to avail appropriate legal remedies, including the alternative remedy available to the petitioner in view of Section 3(o)(i) of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act.

Allowed as prayed for.
