The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner for directions to the respondents No.1 to 4 to conduct a fair, impartial and time-bound investigation in a case arising out of FIR No.71 dated 07.05.2024, under Section 420 of IPC, Police Station B Division, Amritsar.

2. The learned counsel representing the petitioner submits that the petitioner has filed the representation (Annexure P-4) before the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar. The learned counsel prays for directions to the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar to decide the abovementioned representation within the stipulated time.

3. **Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4.**



4. Mr. Eklavya Darshi, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents No.1 to 4/State. Hence service of notice upon the State is hereby dispensed with.

5. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts and circumstances, it is hereby directed that by passing a speaking order within a period of one month from the date of receipt of this order, the representation of petitioners (Annexure P-4) be disposed of either by the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar or, on assignment by him, by any other police officer not below the rank of Deputy Commissioner of Police. It is however clarified that no finding is being returned, by this Court, with regard to merits of the contents of representation. The Commissioner of Police, Amritsar shall be at liberty to make an independent assessment with regard to contents of representation of the petitioner, and take an independent decision at his own level.

6. In view of above, the present petition is hereby disposed of.
