1. The present second petition has been filed under Section 483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short 'BNSS') for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.87 dated 07.03.2021 under Sections 304-B and 498-A of IPC, Sections 87 and 80 of BNS, 2023 registered at Police Station Bilaspur, District Gurugram.

2. At the very outset, learned State counsel, on instruction from the Investigating Officer-ASI Udebir Singh submits that the trial is at the fag end and all the prosecution witnesses have been examined. Now, the matter is fixed before the concerned learned trial Court for defence evidence and arguments.

3. Faced with above, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of the present petition, at this stage.
