1. The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to revise the retiral benefits of the petitioner by considering the entire service rendered by him with the respondent-department as qualifying service, which is more than 37 years, whereas while calculating the retiral benefits, only 29 years of service has been considered as qualifying service, and consequent upon such revision, arrears of pension and other arrears towards retiral/pensionary benefits be released along with interest @ 12% per annum from the date of eligibility till payment, as despite sending legal notices dated 20.08.2018 and 20.07.2019 (Annexures P-9 and P-11) as well as reminders dated



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10.12.2018 and 12.08.2022 (Annexures P-1 & P-12), no action has been taken by the respondents till date.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition has been rendered infructuous as all the service benefits of the petitioner have been released to him.

3. Disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
