On 10.04.2026, the following order was passed:-

*“The learned Senior counsel for the petitioner contends
that the petitioner has been summoned under Section 210
BNSS, 2023 (Section 319 Cr.P.C.).*

Notice of motion for 13.05.2026.

*In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to surrender
before the Trial Court and on his doing so, he shall be
admitted to interim bail to its satisfaction.”*

In compliance of the aforementioned order, the petitioner
has surrendered and has since been released on interim bail.



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The learned counsel for the complainant contends that the petitioner has not disclosed the factum of the first bail application being dismissed. He further contends that the petitioner is the main accused.

Heard.

The aforementioned order records that the prior bail application of the petitioner stands dismissed but later he was declared innocent.

In view of the fact that the petitioner has since surrendered and has been released on interim bail, the order dated 10.04.2026 is made absolute.
