By way of present petition filed under Section 528 of the BNSS, the petitioners are seeking quashing/setting aside of the condition contained in the order dated 10.03.2026 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Sangrur in CRA-131 of 2026, titled “Baljit Singh and another vs. Suhel Singh,” to the extent that it directs the deposit of 20% of the compensation amount as a condition during the pendency of the appeal and for the stay of operation of the said condition.

2. On 18.04.2026, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“i) Present petition has been filed under Section 528 of the BNSS, seeking quashing/setting aside of the condition contained in the order dated 10.03.2026 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Sangrur in CRA-131 of 2026, titled “Baljit Singh and another vs. Suhel Singh,” to the extent that it directs the deposit of 20% of the compensation amount as a condition during the pendency of the appeal and for the stay of operation of the said condition.



ii) *Ms. Akansha, Advocate, appearing as proxy counsel, submits that petitioners are not willing to pursue the present petition and prays that she be permitted to withdraw the same. Present petition has been filed by Mr. Angrej Singh, Advocate; Mr. Avinash Sharma, Advocate; and Mr. Amritpal Singh, Advocate. However, none of them is present before the Court after the filing of the petition to make the said request.*

Proxy counsel is unable to explain any reason for withdrawal as conveyed by the petitioners. Therefore, request is declined at this stage. However, request shall be considered on the next date of hearing if any of the counsel who filed the present petition appears before the Court.

iii) *List on 21.04.2026.”*

3. Today, Mr. Angrej Singh, Advocate appears and makes a statement that he be allowed to withdraw the present petition as he has got necessary instructions in this regard.

4. In view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the petition stands dismissed as withdrawn.
