1. The present petition has been filed under Sections 482/528 of BNSS seeking issuance of a direction to the official respondent Nos. 2 and 3 to decide the presentation dated 29.01.2026 (Annexure P-1) and dated 30.03.2026 (Annexure P-2).

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has recently filed a representation on 30.03.2026 (Annexure P-2) before respondent No. 2-Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran raising her grievances as mentioned in the present petition but the same has not yet been considered and no action has been taken thereon. He further submitted that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No. 2-Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, to decide the aforesaid representation filed by the petitioner and take necessary action thereon.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Ruchika Sabherwal, Senior DAG, Punjab, has advance no-



tice on behalf of the respondents-State and submits that the needful will be done in due course. Let a complete set of the paper-book be supplied to her during the course of the day.

In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No. 2-Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, to decide the aforesaid representation dated 30.03.2026 (Annexure P-2) of the petitioner within a period of one month from today, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law and take necessary action, if so required.
