1. Prayer in the present petition is for initiation of proceedings under Sections 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 against the respondents for alleged willful disobedience of the directions issued by the Writ Court vide order dated 23.01.2026 (Annexure P-1), passed in CWP-1830-2026, whereby direction was issued to the appropriate authority to consider and decide the representation dated 08.01.2026, after providing opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks.

2. Notice of motion.

3. On asking of the Court, Mr. Harshit Singla, A.A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents. He has submitted a copy of a speaking order dated 30.03.2026, passed by Director General, Health Services, Haryana and submits that the aforesaid order dated 23.01.2026 stands complied with.

4. Copy of the speaking order dated 30.03.2026 is taken on record. Registry to tag the same at appropriate place.



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5. Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of as having rendered infructuous. However, the petitioner is granted liberty to assail the correctness of the aforesaid speaking order dated 30.03.2026, if so advised.
