MANISHA BATRA, J (ORAL):-

Through the instant petition under Section 482 of the Bharatiya
Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short 'BNSS'), the petitioner seeks
anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 52 dated 13.03.2026 registered under
Sections 420, 465, 468, 471, 120-B of IPC at Police Station Sultanwind,
Police Commissionerate, District Amritsar.

2. Vide order dated 15.04.2026 passed by this Court, the petitioner
was released on interim bail and was directed to join investigation.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Avtar Singh
states that the petitioner has joined the investigation on 19.04.2026 and she is
not required for custodial interrogation.

4. In view of the fact that the petitioner has already joined the



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investigation on 19.04.2026 and the given nature of allegations, her pre-trial incarceration is not required. As such, without commenting on merits of case, it is observed that a case for release of petitioner on bail is made out. Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the order 15.04.2026 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to compliance of conditions laid down in Section 482(2) of BNSS.

5. Since the main petition has already been disposed of, pending application, if any, is rendered infructuous.
