The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India *inter alia* seeking a writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing respondent No.3 to take necessary action on the complaint dated 11.08.2025 (Annexure P-1) and inquiry report dated 14.01.2026 (Annexure P-2) submitted by respondent No.5 against respondent No.7.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to pursue his remedies before the authorities appointed under the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act (in short 'the
