The instant contempt petition alleges willful disobedience of the order dated 26.02.2026 (Annexure P-4), passed in CRWP-1698-2026, vide which the following directions were issued:-

**“From the response of the State, it is evident that official process on the representations of the petitioner is under way. The victim is directed to join the enquiry immediately and thereafter the representations shall be disposed of within fifteen days by taking necessary action, as per law. Adequate protection shall be provided to the petitioner, in case threat is perceived.**

**The petition stands disposed of.”**

2. At the outset, learned State counsel, on instructions from Ms. Akarshi, ACP, Jalandhar, submits that in compliance of the aforesaid directions, the representation submitted by the petitioner stands decided, vide order dated 14.04.2026 passed by the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar. It has been stated that as per the said order, there is no



requirement of police protection for the complainant and the complaint has been ordered to be consigned to record.

3. That being so, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner does not wish to press the instant contempt petition and shall, if so advised, avail all such remedies as shall be admissible in law, if the petitioner is aggrieved by the decision on the representation.

4. In view of the statement given by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present contempt petition is disposed of in terms thereof.

5. Pending application(s), if any, also stands disposed of.
