1. In the present writ petition, the petitioner has challenged the order dated 06.04.2026 (Annexure P-4) passed by the respondent No.4, vide which, the petitioner was ordered to be compulsory retired from service on attaining the age of 55 years.

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that in light of the instructions dated 05.02.2019 (Annexure P-1) issued by the respondents, last 10 years service record has to be taken into consideration for the purpose of premature retirement. He submits that if, 10 years service record of the petitioner is taken into consideration prior to issuance of the notice dated 06.04.2026 (Annexure P-4), as there is no adverse ACR against the petitioner, the petitioner cannot be compulsory retired from service. Learned counsel submits that against the abovesaid notice, the petitioner has also submitted a representation dated



08.04.2026 (Annexure P-5) in terms of the abovesaid instruction dated 05.02.2019 (Annexure P-1).

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Gaurav Jindal, Addl. AG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State. He submits that as the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 08.04.2026 (Annexure P-5) as such, this petition may be disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to consider and decide the abovesaid representation submitted by the petitioner.

5. In view of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to consider and decide the representation dated 08.04.2026 (Annexure P-5) submitted by the petitioner within a period of 10 days from today.

6. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, also stand(s) disposed of.
