KULDEEP TIWARI, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioners, through the instant writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, pray for issuance of a Mandamus upon respondents No.2 to 7, to decide representations dated 09.04.2026 and 10.04.2026 (Annexures P-2 to P-4).

2. It is a matter of record that petitioners moved the authorities concerned with regard to their grievances by way of the representations dated 09.04.2026 and 10.04.2026, and the present writ petition was filed only on 16.04.2026, i.e. after 6 days. Therefore, apparently, the authorities concerned were not even afforded due time to take cognizance of the matter.

3. In such circumstances, this Court refrains itself from entertaining the petition, being a pre-mature motion, at this stage, and the same is **dismissed**. However, the petitioners shall be at liberty to raise all such pleas, as raised in the petition, before the authorities concerned, which shall consider and deal therewith, in accordance with law.
