The petition has been filed challenging the order dated 07.04.2026, Annexure P-3, whereby the petitioner, who was working as Lecturer (Computer Engineer), has been transferred from Government Polytechnic, Jhajjar, to Government Polytechnic, Dhamlawas, Rewari.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is suffering from Epilepsy as apparent from the medical certificate, dated 27.02.2026, Annexure P-2. The certificate has been issued by Dr. Neeraj Kumar, Assistant Professor, Department of Neurology, PGIMS, Rohtak; he is the doctor from whom the petitioner has been getting regular treatment for quite long, and on being transferred outside Rohtak, he would suffer medically.

3. Considering the submissions, this Court finds no ground to interfere with the transfer order. It goes without saying that the transfer is an incidence of service and does not amount to any punishment. Besides, the disease the petitioner is suffering from can also be treated at Rewari, or he



can continue with the treatment from the concerned doctor at Rohtak, as the place is only around ninety kilometres away.

4. In view thereof, finding no merit in the petition, it stands dismissed *in limine*.
