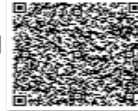

1. This petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* seeking protection of life and liberty of the petitioners and their family members at the hands of respondents No.4 to 18 as they are threatening the petitioners with dire consequences. It is also prayed that the official respondents be directed to decide the representation dated 15.04.2026 (Annexure P-5) submitted by petitioner No.1 in accordance with law.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioner No.1 has preferred a representation/complaint dated 15.04.2026 (Annexure P-5) to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Rupnagar, but no action has been taken so far. Learned counsel also submits that the petitioners would be satisfied if directions are issued to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of

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Police, Rupnagar to look into the aforesaid representation/complaint dated 15.04.2026 (Annexure P-5) and take appropriate steps in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. P.S. Pandher, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the material available on record.

6. Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and the limited prayer made by the petitioners, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Rupnagar, to consider and decide the representation/complaint dated 15.04.2026 (Annexure P-5) of the petitioners in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
