RAJESH BHARDWAJ, J.

1. This is the third petition filed by the petitioner for grant of regular bail to him in case FIR No.166 dated 27.09.2025, under Sections 25, 54, 59 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station City Khanna 2, District Ludhiana.

2. Petitioner earlier approached this Court twice by way of filing CRM-M-67102-2025 and CRM-M-2773-2026 for grant of regular bail, however, the same were dismissed vide orders dated 05.12.2025 and 10.02.2026, respectively. Now the present petition has been filed by the petitioner with the same prayer just after 02 months.

3. However, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the witnesses are intentionally not appearing before the trial Court to prolong the incarceration of the petitioner.



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4. This Court does not find any change in circumstances which would entitle the petitioner for grant of regular bail. Hence, the present petition is dismissed at this stage. However, prosecution is directed to ensure the presence of the witnesses for their examination on the date fixed before the trial Court.
