1. In the present writ petition, the petitioners are praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to grant 01 increment to the petitioners on completion of more than six months before retirement by granting the same and to fix the pension on the last pay drawn with all consequential retiral benefits. Reliance is made to the judgment dated 24.04.2025 (Annexure P-8) passed by this Court in **CWP-14627-2024 (and other connected cases)** titled as **Mahabir Singh Tanwar Vs. State of Haryana and others.**

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners, on instructions from the petitioners, submits that the petitioners would be satisfied if at this stage, a direction is given to respondent No.4 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 10.11.2025 (Annexure P-9) served by the petitioners in a time-bound manner.

4. Mr. Gaurav Jindal, Addl. AG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State and does not oppose the prayer made by the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners.

In view of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 10.11.2025 (Annexure P-9) served by the petitioners, in accordance with law/rules, within a period of 03 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
6. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand(s) disposed of.
