The present civil writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari* for quashing the impugned order dated 01.12.2025 (Annexure P-19) passed by respondent No.4 as well as letter dated 31.01.2025 (Annexure P-18) issued by respondent No.1. Further, for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to give appointment to the petitioner on compassionate grounds in view of her qualifications.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file fresh petition with better particulars.

3. Learned counsel for the respondent-Corporation opposes the prayer on the ground that the petitioner had earlier withdrawn a writ petition with similar liberty and further submits that the petitioner is not eligible in terms of Clause 6 of the policy, as her husband is gainfully employed
