1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to consider and decide his representation dated 16.03.2026 seeking Police Clearance Certificate.

2. The petitioner is facing trial arising out of FIR No.40 dated 18.05.2022 registered under Sections 323, 365, 427, 458 and 34 of IPC at Police Station Sadar Pathankot. He filed an application before the trial Court seeking permission to visit abroad. The said application was allowed with liberty to the petitioner to visit New Zealand till June' 2026. He was granted permission to procure valid visa as well as ticket to visit New Zealand till June' 2026. He applied for Police Clearance Certificate in the Office of District Police, Pathankot vide application dated 26.12.2025. The application is yet to be adjudicated. He has served legal notice dated 16.03.2026 upon respondents.



3. Learned counsel representing the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the petition with liberty to file fresh application seeking Police Clearance Certificate.

4. ***Dismissed*** as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
