1. The present petition has been filed alleging violation of order dated 15.01.2026 (Annexure P-1) passed by a co-ordinate Bench in CRM-M-1620-2026, titled as '*Gianinder Partap vs. State of Punjab and others*' whereby respondent No. 3-SHO, Police Station Sahnewal, District Ludhiana, Punjab to dispose of the representation dated 13.12.2025 filed by the petitioner within a period of 03 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the said order.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the respondents on instructions submits that the respondents have not received any representation from the petitioner.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has first submitted that copy of the representation was sent to respondents through e-mail; and then he subsequently submits that physical copy was also given to the respondents. However, learned counsel admits that no receipt/acknowledgement was taken thereupon.



4. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition, with liberty to the petitioner to file fresh one with better particulars or if so advised.

5. Permitted to do so.

6. Dismissed as withdrawn, with the liberty aforesaid.
