1. The present contempt petition has been filed for deliberate and intentional disobedience of order dated 05.05.2025 passed by this Court in CWP-12600-2025, whereby without commenting upon the merits of the case, writ petition was disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the representation dated 11.03.2025 filed by the petitioner.
