In the present writ petition, the petitioner has challenged the order dated 12.03.2026 (Annexure P-6) to the extent that the name of petitioner does not figure in the said order for the purpose of undergoing the Lower School Course under Rule 19.22 of Punjab Police Rules, 1934. The petitioner has further prayed for direction to the respondents to depute him for Lower School Course, which has commenced from 27.03.2026.

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the case of the petitioner has already been recommended by respondent No.5 to respondent No.3 for the purpose of undergoing Lower School Course.



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3. Learned counsel, on instructions from the petitioner, submits that at this stage, petitioner will be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.5 to decide the representation dated 26.03.2026 (Annexure P-8) submitted by the petitioner, in a time bound manner.

4. Notice of motion.

5. Mr. Rohit Ahuja, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents and does not object to the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No.5 to consider and decide the representation dated 26.03.2026 (Annexure P-8), submitted by the petitioner within a period of 01 month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order in accordance with law.

7. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand(s) disposed of accordingly.
