The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of BNSS seeking issuance of appropriate directions to respondents No.3 and 4 to conduct a fair and impartial investigation in FIR No.53, dated 01.04.2026, registered under Sections 115(2), 118(1), 351(1), 351(3), 191(3) and 190 of the BNS, at Police Station Kotwali Patiala, District Patiala.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.3 to decide or take necessary action on the representation dated 07.04.2026 (Annexure P-2) filed by the petitioner raising her grievance which has not been considered and no action has been taken till date.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Ruchika Sabherwal, learned Senior DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, has accepted the notice on behalf of the respondent-State



and submits that the needful will be done in due course. Let a complete set of the paperbook be supplied to her during the course of the day.

In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the aforesaid representation dated 07.04.2026 (Annexure P-2) of the petitioner within a period of one month from today, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.
