In the present writ petition, the petitioners are praying for issuance of a direction to the respondents to grant arrears for a period of 38 months prior to 11.04.2013, which accrued to the petitioners in pursuance to the letter dated 11.04.2013 (Annexure P-5), along with the interest @ 18% per annum till its realization.

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits that the benefit claimed by the petitioners has already been granted to the similarly situated persons.

3. Learned counsel, on instructions from the petitioners, submits that at this stage, petitioners will be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.3 to decide the legal notice dated 08.12.2025 (Annexure P-13) served by the petitioners, in a time bound manner.
