Petition herein is, *inter alia*, for issuance of a writ in the nature of *Mandamus* for directing respondent No.2 to remove the name and mobile number of respondent No.6 from the property ID No.3AE81FPO and add the name and mobile number of petitioner in the said property ID No.3AE81FPO.

1.1. A further prayer has been made for directing respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 19.02.2026 (Annexure P-8), submitted by the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as regards the relief claimed in the instant writ petition, the petitioner has moved representation dated 19.02.2026 (Annexure P-8) before the respondent authorities; however, the same has not been adverted to by the concerned

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authority, till date. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner would be satisfied at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the concerned/competent authority to consider and decide the aforesaid representation dated 19.02.2026 (Annexure P-8).

3. Ms. Upasana Dhawan, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, appears on behalf of respondents-State, in pursuance of the advance copy of paper book having already been supplied to the State. She on instructions from Mr. Gulshan Kumar, Secretary, Municipal Council, Ambala submits that respondent No.4 (The Secretary, Municipal Council, Ambala)/competent authority shall take decision either way, on the pending representation dated 19.02.2026 (Annexure P-8), within a period of three months from today.

4. Keeping in view the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties and without commenting on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 (The Secretary, Municipal Council, Ambala)/competent authority to consider and decide representation dated 19.02.2026 (Annexure P-8), by way of passing a speaking order, after affording due opportunity of hearing to all the concerned parties, within a period of three months from today.

5. All the pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
