1. In the present writ petition, the petitioner is praying for issuance of a direction to the respondents to fix his pay and pension in accordance with the order dated 01.07.2023 (Annexure P-2) passed by the Appellate Authority.

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the petitioner had earlier filed a writ petition, being **CWP No.21594 of 2024, titled as 'Mohd. Rafi Vs. State of Punjab and others', decided on 02.09.2024**, wherein the respondents-State gave a statement to comply with the order dated 01.07.2023 (Annexure P-2) within a period of 03 months. He further submits that till date, the order passed by the Appellate Authority dated 01.07.2023 (Annexure P-2) has not been complied with.
