1. The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking issuance of a writ of certiorari for quashing the order dated 09.09.2025 (Annexure P-10), passed by respondent No.1, rejecting the claim of the petitioner and order dated 18.01.2025 (Annexure P-8) to the extent, whereby all four General Category posts of Tutors in the Department of Obstetrics and Gynaecology, sought to be filled in pursuant to memo dated 18.08.2023 (Annexure P-6), but not filled and rather now one post of General Category has been kept unfilled saying that it is meant for Handicapped category. Further, seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus, directing the respondents to consider and grant the petitioner appointment by way of promotion to the post of Tutor under General Category in the abovesaid department against an unfilled post, from the date of promotion given to others i.e. vide order dated 18.01.2025 (Annexure P-8) with all consequential benefits.

2. After arguing the case for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner, wishes to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to file fresh one on the same cause of action with better particulars.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
