1. The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for praying for issuance of a Writ in the nature of Mandamus for issuance of appropriate directions especially to Respondent No.3 to act and pass a speaking order on the letter/representation dated 17.02.2026 (Annexure P-6) given by the petitioners which has been duly received by Respondent No.3 on 23.02.2026, whereby in the application, it is requested that necessary directions be issued to Respondent No.5 for entering the Vasika in the name of the petitioners and their brothers in-terms of the conveyance deed dated 19.03.1997 (Annexure P-1) pertaining to land situated in Village Bhurj Mattewara, Hadbast No.46, District Ludhiana.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he will be satisfied in case a direction be issued to the respondent/State to decide the representation dated 17.02.2026 (Annexure P-6).



3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. Rajiv Verma, Addl. AG. Punjab, having served with an advance copy of the petition, has put in appearance on behalf of respondent/State and assures the Court that the above-said representation will be decided within time bound manner.
5. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, respondent No. 3 – Deputy Commissioner, Ludhiana is directed to decide the representation dated 17.02.2026 (Annexure P-6) after providing opportunity of hearing to the petitioners and by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from today, and a copy of the said speaking order shall be supplied to the petitioners within one week thereafter.
6. The petition in the aforesaid terms stands disposed off.
