The petition has been filed *inter alia* seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to promote the petitioner to the post of PGT Hindi with effect from 06.05.2016, the date her juniors have been promoted, with all consequential benefits.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that grievance raised herein is pending for appropriate decision before the respondents. At this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case respondent no.2 is directed to decide her pending legal notice, dated 09.02.2026, Annexure P-19, in a specified period.

4. Mr. Sunil Ranga, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents/State and submits that the pending legal notice, dated 09.02.2026, will be decided by respondent no.2/Director



General, Secondary Education, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within three months.

5. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.

6. Ordered accordingly.

7. In case the order is not passed, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioner.
