This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 4 to ensure protection of the life and personal liberty of the petitioner and to take appropriate preventive and protective measures against respondents No.5 to 17 so as to ensure that the petitioner is not subjected to any harm, threat, harassment, illegal detention or false implicated in criminal cases.

2. Learned Senior counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has preferred a representation/complaint dated 18.02.2026 (Annexure P-3) and a legal notice dated 04.03.2026 (Annexure P-4) to respondents No.2 and 3 but no action has been taken so far. Learned Senior counsel also submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if directions are issued to respondent No.4-Senior Superintendent of Police(Rural), Jalandhar to look into the representation/complaint dated 18.02.2026 (Annexure P-3) and legal notice

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dated 04.03.2026 (Annexure P-4) and take appropriate steps in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 5 only at this stage.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. P.S. Pandher, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 5.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the material available on record.

6. Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and the limited prayer made by the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4-Senior Superintendent of Police(Rural), Jalandhar, to consider and decide the representation/complaint dated 18.02.2026 (Annexure P-3) and legal notice dated 04.03.2026 (Annexure P-4) of the petitioner in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
