SANDEEP MOUDGIL, J. (ORAL)

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1. The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the outstanding payment for Consultancy Service fee amounting to Rs.6,93,750/- along with interest @ 24% per annum rendered by the petitioner to 37 industries of Haryana from 2016 to 2020 as the said amount has already been approved and verified by the concerned Audit and Account Departments of respondent-University.

2. At this stage, learned counsel appearing for respondents No.1 and 2 would state that he has the instructions to state that in case the petitioner is found legally entitled to the relief sought in the instant petition, the same would be released to him positively after considering the pleas raised in the legal notice dated 05.12.2025 (Annexure P-15).



3. In view of the above, petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider the pleas raised by the petitioner in his legal notice dated 05.12.2025 (Annexure P-15) as well as in the present writ petition in accordance with law, after providing due opportunity of personal hearing to the petitioner, within a period of 04 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, by passing a speaking order. The order so passed shall be furnished to the petitioner within one week thereafter.

5. The petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
