The petition has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to count the past service rendered by the petitioner from 06.07.1984 to 05.11.1991 in C. R. Z. High School, Sonipat, for the purpose of pensionary benefits.

2. Learned counsel could not refer to any document on record establishing that the petitioner was appointed on a sanctioned post during that period. Some photocopies of the register entries at page 32 and 33 of the writ petition have been referred to by him which only indicate that he resigned from service on 05.11.1991 (forenoon). No rule or regulation has been cited under which such a past service can be counted for pensionary benefits.



3. Accordingly, there is nothing to show that the petitioner's claim seeking counting of his service towards pensionary benefits is maintainable.

4. Dismissed.
