1. The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant the pay scale meant for the post of Sub Divisional Engineer from the dates the respondents had taken work from late husband of the petitioner of the post of Sub Divisional Engineer and the petitioner be granted all consequential benefits arising out of it in lieu of judgments passed by this Court in C WP-9083-2015 decided on 22.11.2017 (P-4) and further in lieu of order passed by State of Haryana dated 17.12.2018 (P-7) vide which the benefits have been granted to similarly situated employees.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. Deepak Balyan, Addl. AG Haryana, having been served with an advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and assures the Court that the advance notice dated 16.09.2023 (Annexure P-3) shall be decided, by passing a speaking order, in accordance with law.



4. In view of the above, without advertent to the merits of the case, respondents/competent authority is directed to decide the advance notice dated 16.09.2023 (Annexure P-3), in accordance with law, after considering the orders passed in the writ petition filed by other employees who are similarly placed as is the deceased husband of the petitioner in **CWP-4864-2011** and **CWP-9083-2015**, decided on 22.11.2017 (Annexure P-4), **LPA No.1528-2015** dismissed on 20.10.2015 (Annexure P-5) as well as **Special Leave Petition (C) No.5944-2017** dismissed by the Hon'ble Apex Court vide judgment dated 14.09.2018 (Annexure P-6) upholding the order passed by this Court dated 22.11.2017 (Annexure P-4) in **CWP-9083-2015**, within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. The order so passed shall be furnished to the petitioner within one week thereafter.

5. The petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
