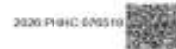

1. Present petition has been filed praying for preserving the call detail record as well as Tower Locations of the Mobile numbers mentioned in the head note as well as in the prayer clause of the present petition for the period w.e.f. 22.03.2025 to 27.03.2025 in case relating to FIR No.103, dated 26.03.2026, under Sections 21(C), 29 of NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Sadar Sirsa, District Sirsa. Further prayer has been made for directing the Courts below to decide the application filed by the petitioner to preserve the call detail record as well as tower locations in a time bound manner in light of the facts mentioned below and for staying the further proceedings of the abovementioned FIR during the pendency of the present petition.



2. It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has been prosecuted in case bearing FIR No.103, dated 26.03.2026, under Sections 21(C), 29 of NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Sadar Sirsa, District Sirsa. He has submitted that the petitioner has filed the application before the learned trial Court for preserving the call detail record as well as tower locations of mobile numbers mentioned in the head note as well as the prayer clause of the present petition, however, till date the application is pending adjudication and no decision has been taken on the same. He has submitted that now the application is fixed for 21.05.2026.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On asking of the Court, Mr. Sumit Jain, Addl. A.G., Haryana appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

5. Heard.

6. In view of the above said position, the present petition stands disposed of. The learned trial Court concerned is directed to expedite the hearing of the application filed by the petitioner before it, which is pending adjudication for 21.05.2026 and decide the same expeditiously preferably within a period of one month from 21.05.2026, i.e. the date fixed before it in the application, in accordance with law.
