The petition has been filed *inter alia* seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to grant full amount of medical reimbursement of ₹5,32,542 incurred for the surgery/implant for neuro-intervention treatment of the petitioner's wife along with interest at the rate of twelve per cent on the delayed payment.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that grievance raised herein is pending for appropriate decision before the respondents. At this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case respondent no.2 is directed to decide his pending legal notice, dated 21.02.2026, Annexure P-3, in a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Aakash Singla, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents/State and submits that the pending



legal notice, dated 21.02.2026, will be decided by respondent no.2/Director General, Secondary Education, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within three months.

5. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.

6. Ordered accordingly.

7. In case the order is not passed, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioner.
