The petitioners have filed the instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking issuance of a writ of certiorari for quashing the order dated 02.05.2024 (P-20), passed by respondent No.1 in Contempt Petition No.17 of 2024 in Petition No.63 of 2023 as the same has been passed without deciding the application of petitioner No.2 for vacation of stay of the order dated 12.10.2023.

Learned counsel for respondent No.4 has produced a copy of the order dated 29.08.2025 passed by the Tribunal and submits that the contempt petition filed before the Tribunal has been withdrawn by respondent No.4, vide order dated 29.08.2025, and therefore, the instant petition has been rendered infructuous.
