The instant petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for quashing of order dated 06.03.2026, passed by the Court of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Faridabad in case bearing COMA No. 69 of 2022, titled as ***State of Haryana vs. M/s PSA Nitrogen Pvt. Ltd.***, whereby the bail of petitioners No. 2 and 3 has been cancelled and non-bailable warrants have been issued against them.

2. After advancing arguments at length, learned counsel for the petitioners could not point out any illegality or infirmity in the impugned order. However, he has submitted that since petitioners No. 2 and 3 are willing to join the proceedings, they may be granted liberty to surrender before the learned trial Court.

3. Keeping in view the limited prayer made by the said petitioners and the fact that they are ready to join the Court proceedings which would



obviously help in speedy conclusion of trial, the present petition is disposed of. Petitioners No. 2 and 3 are directed to surrender before the learned trial Court within a period of one week from today and on doing so, the learned trial Court shall release them on bail, subject to their furnishing fresh personal/surety bonds to its satisfaction.

4. Till the appearance of these petitioners before the learned trial Court, their arrest shall remain stayed.

5. It is made clear that in case the petitioners fail to appear before the learned trial Court within the stipulated time, this petition shall be deemed to be dismissed.

6. However, it is clarified that in case the petitioners do not appear before the learned trial Court on subsequent dates, the learned trial Court shall be at liberty to cancel their bail.

7. **CRM-17686-2026**

No case for staying the proceedings is made out. Accordingly, this application is dismissed.

8. **CRM-17687-2026**

In the wake of the order passed in the main petition, this application is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
