1. This petition has been filed under Section 528 BNSS (482 Cr.P.C.) for quashing the impugned order dated 25.03.2026 (Annexure P-4) passed by the Ld. Special Court, Mansa whereby bail and surety bonds of petitioner have been cancelled and non bailable warrants have been issued in case FIR No.0085 dated 02.06.2021 u/s 21, 29, 61, 85 of the Narcotics Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Sardulgarh, District Mansa.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was suffering from acute viral Hepatitis and was advised bed rest. Consequently, he could not appear before the learned trial Court on the date fixed. As such, his bail and surety bonds have been cancelled and non bailable warrants have been issued against him vide order dated 25.03.2026 (Annexure P-4). Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner is ready and willing to join the proceedings before the Court and prays that the impugned order be set aside.

3. Notice of motion.



4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Parneet Singh Pandher, A.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

5. I have heard the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner and gone through the case file.

6. In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, this Court does not find any legitimate ground to interfere in the impugned order dated 25.03.2026 passed by the learned Special Court, Mansa. However, in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within next 07 working days from today and moves an application for grant of regular bail, the same shall be considered and decided by the Court concerned within a period of five days.

7. The petition stands disposed of.
