The petition has been filed seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to count the past service rendered by the petitioner from 02.01.2007 to 23.08.2019 under the Panchayat and Development Department, Haryana, for the purpose of pensionary benefits.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that grievance raised herein is pending for appropriate decision before the respondents. At this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case respondent no.2 is directed to decide the pending legal notice, dated 05.03.2026, Annexure P-5, in a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Aakash Singla, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents/State and submits that the pending legal notice, dated 05.03.2026, will be decided by respondent no.2/Director, Secondary Education, by passing a speaking/reasoned order in accordance with law within a period of three months.



5. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.

6. Ordered accordingly.

7. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioner.
