N.S. SHEKHAWAT, J.

1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to quash FIR No.109 dated 04.10.2017 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 323/341/506/148/149/120-B IPC (Sections 325/307 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Sadar Rupnagar, District Rupnagar.

2. After arguing the matter at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to raise all the pleas available to him before the trial Court at an appropriate stage.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

4. Needless to observe that the trial Court shall proceed with the trial on the basis of material produced before it. Apart from that, in case, the petitioner moves an application for exemption from personal appearance



before the trial Court, the same shall be considered by the trial Court sympathetically. While granting exemption from personal appearance, the trial Court would be at liberty to impose any condition as it may deem fit and appropriate and may also insist on the presence of the petitioner on any date of hearing.

5. Since the FIR in the present case was registered on 04.10.2017, it is expected that the trial Court shall proceed with the matter expeditiously.
