1 In the present writ petition, the petitioner has challenged the order dated 24.03.2026 (Annexure P-7), whereby, whole sale drug licenses granted to the petitioner have been suspended for a period of 07 days from 24.04.2026 to 30.04.2026. It has also been prayed that operation of the order dated 24.03.2026 (Annexure P-7) may also be stayed till the filing of the statutory appeal by the petitioner.

2. Learned senior counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the impugned order dated 24.03.2026 (Annexure P-7) was received by the petitioner on 20.04.2026 (afternoon), as such, the petitioner was not in a position to file an appeal immediately before the competent authority as various records/data are required to be attached



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with the appeal. Learned senior counsel submits that the petitioner will file an appeal before the competent authority on or before 28.04.2026 and till then, the operation of the abovesaid impugned order may kindly be stayed.

3. It is settled law that the parties have a right to file an effective appeal. Taking into consideration the peculiar facts of the present case and without going into the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction that liberty is granted to the petitioner to file an appeal before the competent authority on or before 28.04.2026. In case any appeal is filed, the impugned order dated 24.03.2026 (Annexure P-7) will be given effect to starting from 29.04.2026 instead of 24.04.2026 subject to any order to be passed in appeal by the Appellate Authority. The Appellate Authority is requested to decide the appeal as expeditiously as possible.

4. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, also stands disposed of.
