The present writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India with a prayer for issuance of an appropriate writ or order in the nature of *certiorari* for quashing the impugned order dated 23.02.2021 (Annexure P-1) passed by respondent No.3. Further praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to grant appointment of the petitioner on compassionate grounds.

2. Today, the present case was called twice, but none has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner. Even on the last date of hearing i.e. 19.02.2026 there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner.
