This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to grant notional benefits to the petitioners at par with the petitioners of CWP No. 18044 of 2014 decided on 19.05.2016 (Annexure P-1) as directed by the Hon'ble Court vide judgment dated 09.10.2018 (Annexure P-2) passed in CWP No. 14326 of 2017 and connected petitions which was upheld by the Division Bench vide judgment dated 22.12.2022 (Annexure P-3) passed in LPA No. 548 of 2019 and connected LPAs.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he will be satisfied, in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to consider the legal notice dated 30.03.2026 (Annexure P-7) within a time bound manner.



3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. Deepak Balyan, Addl. A.G., Haryana having been served with an advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and assures the Court that the legal notice dated 30.03.2026 (Annexure P-7) shall be decided by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.
5. In view of the above, and without advertng to the merits of the case, the respondent No.2-Director General, Transport Department, Chandigarh is directed to consider and decide the legal notice dated 30.03.2026 (Annexure P-7), after providing opportunity of hearing to the petitioners, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
6. A copy of order so passed be supplied to the petitioners within seven days thereafter.
7. Petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
