1. The prayer wrapped in the instant writ petition is for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the application dated 24.12.2025 (Annexure P-2) filed by the petitioner along with the required online fee of Rs.1500/- deposited on 24.12.2025 (Annexure P-3), for the grant of a Stage Carriage Permit.

2. During the course of arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner fairly submits that, at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the respondent No.2 to decide the application (supra) within a stipulated time period.

3. Mr. Sahil R. Bakshi, learned Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, who, on receipt of an advance copy of the writ petition, is present in Court on behalf of the respondents. He, on instructions from Baljinder Singh Dhillon, PCS, Regional Transport Authority, Jalandhar, submits that there is



no objection in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the application (*supra*) within a stipulated time period.

4. Without evincing any opinion as regards the merits of this writ petition, this Court deems it appropriate to direct the respondent No.2 to take a final decision on the application (*supra*) within eight weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
