1. The main grievance which propelled the present petitioner to approach this Court by casting instant petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is the indolent and lackadaisical approach of the authority concerned, in not taking final decision on his application dated 27.08.2021, and legal notice dated 07.11.2025 (Annexures P-2 and P-3 respectively).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied, in case a *mandamus* is passed upon respondents, to take a final decision on his application and representation (*supra*), in a time bound manner.

3. On the other hand, learned State counsel, on instructions from Mr. Baljinder Singh Dhillon, Secretary, RTA, Jalandhar, submits that he has no objection, if the aforesaid direction is passed upon the respondent authorities.



4. In view of the above, and considering the prayer, as made by learned counsel for the petitioner, innocuous and *bona fide*, this Court, without observing anything on merits of the instant case, directs the respondent authorities, to take a final decision on the application (*supra*) and representation (*supra*), by passing a speaking order, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

5. **Disposed of** accordingly.
