Petition herein is, *inter alia*, seeking a writ in the nature of Mandamus, for staying the dispossession of the petitioners during the pendency of ROR No.139 of 2025-26 titled as Balbir and Anr. Vs. Satish and Others dated 05.03.2026 (Annexure P-3) and ROR No.138 of 2025-26 titled as Balbir and Anr. Vs. Satish and Others dated 05.03.2026 (Annexure P-4) filed by the petitioners.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that although the petitioner has preferred revision petitions bearing ROR No. 139 of 2025-26 and ROR No. 138 of 2025-26, which are presently pending consideration for 25.05.2026; however, for the last 2-3 occasions, learned Financial Commissioner has not held the Court, therefore, his prayer for stay made in the application filed alongwith the revision petitions could not be pressed.
