1. The present petition has been filed seeking grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 139 dated 26.08.2023 under Sections 376-D, 313, 511 and 120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station City Budhlada, District Mansa, Punjab.

2. At the outset, learned State counsel has pointed out that the DNA report is still awaited and the cross-examination of the complainant is underway.

3. Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner fairly prays for withdrawal of the present petition, while seeking appropriate directions to the learned Trial Court to expedite the trial. He further prays that necessary directions be also issued to the concerned authorities to



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furnish the DNA report at the earliest so as to enable the petitioner to avail the concession of bail.

4. At this stage, learned State counsel submits that the requisite D.O. letter to the concerned authorities seeking the DNA report has already been issued on 18.03.2026 and, as per the response received, the report is likely to be received by the second week of April, 2026.

5. In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn at this stage, with a direction to the concerned authorities to submit the DNA report before the learned Trial Court within four weeks from today.

6. In addition, the learned Trial Court shall make a positive endeavour to complete the testimony of all the material witnesses, including the complainant, in accordance with law.
