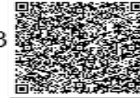

1. This petition has been filed under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 (erstwhile Section 482 Cr.P.C.) seeking issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to conduct the investigation fairly, properly and expeditiously on the complaint dated 28.04.2026 (Annexure P-1) submitted by petitioner No.1 to respondents No.2 & 3 for taking legal action against the private respondents and after conducting investigation, an FIR may be registered against the private respondents/accused persons under the appropriate provisions of law.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has preferred a representation/complaint dated 28.04.2026 (Annexure P-1) to respondents No.2 and 3, but no action has been taken so far.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Rakesh Kumar Jangra, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

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5. Mr. Amarjeet Singh and Mr. Rajesh Tushar, Advocate have put in appearance on behalf of respondents No.5 to 8, 10, 15 & 16 and filed the power of attorney in Court, which is taken on record.

6. Learned State counsel, upon instructions submits that the petitioner and the private respondents are involved in a property dispute and both sides have levelled allegations against each other. It is also submitted that upon inquiry, the allegations were found to be false and DDR No.30 dated 28.04.2026 has already been recorded and the complaints have been consigned/filed accordingly.

7. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, this Court does not find any ground to issue further directions in the matter. Consequently, the present petition is dismissed.

8. However, the petitioners shall be at liberty to avail their alternative remedies in accordance with law.
